
















DECODING ALLERGY IN THE ESOPHAGUS:
INTERESTING FACTS YOU CAN WOW YOUR DOC AND FRIENDS WITH!

EOSINOPHILIC ESOPHAGITIS (ALLERGIC ESOPHAGITIS) IS COMMON! MANY
PEOPLE IN THE U.S. AND AROUND THE WORLD HAVE IT.

DIFFERENT PEOPLE CAN HAVE DIFFERENT SYMPTOMS WITH EOE. SYMPTOMS CAN INCLUDE DIFFICULTY SWALLOWING (DYSPHAGIA), PAIN WITH SWALLOWING (ODYNOPHAGIA), REGURGITATION, VOMITING, AND STOMACH PAIN.

PEOPLE WITH EOE CAN HAVE OTHER TYPES OF ALLERGIES AS WELL... SUCH AS ASTHMA (ALLERGY IN THE LUNGS), ECZEMA (ALLERGY IN THE SKIN) OR HAY FEVER (SEASONAL ALLERGIES)...BUT NOT EVERYONE DOES.

DIAGNOSIS REQUIRES AN ENDOSCOPY: TO DIAGNOSIS EOE, DOCTORS DO AN ENDOSCOPY TO LOOK FOR ALLERGY CELLS (ALSO CALLED EOSINOPHILS) IN THE ESOPHAGUS, AFTER TREATMENT THEY WILL DO ANOTHER ENDOSCOPY TO MAKE SURE THE ALLERGY CELLS HAVE GONE AWAY!
